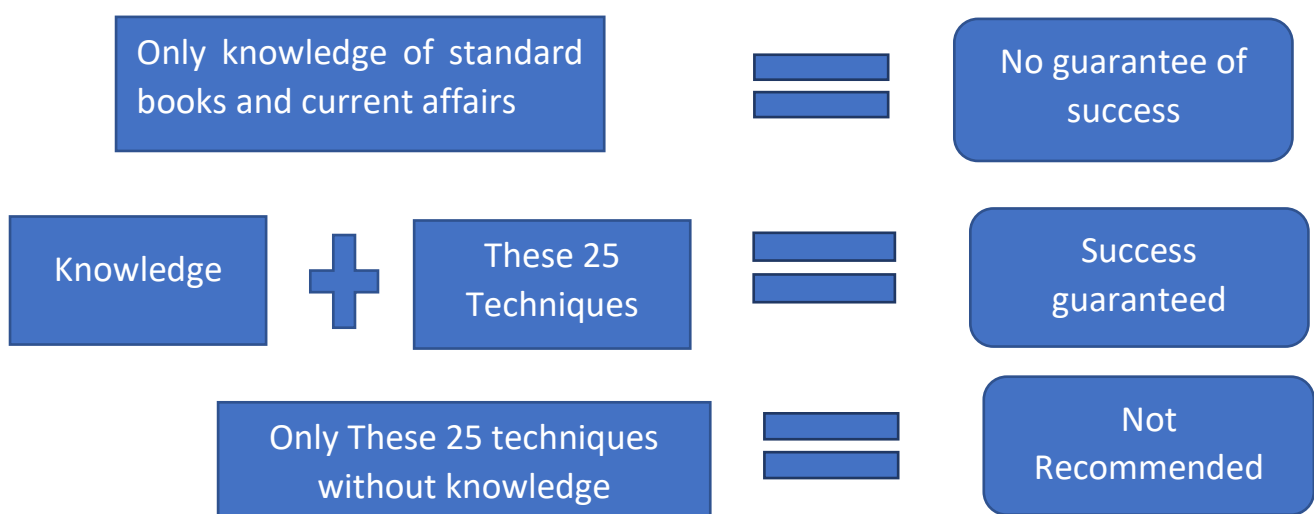

**POSITIVE RULE 4:** Matching Type: For 4 OR MORE Statements. most of the time, when examiners asked to match content between “A” AND “B”, he interchanges at least between 2 statements. Hence, if there are even statements, then the option with even statements will be the correct choice. Same as above...If odd then ODD.

Note: this rule does not apply to questions where there are only 3 statements.
